Dear Mr. Speaker, Mr. Majority Leader, Mr. Majority Whip, and Mr. Chairman:

Would \$40 billion help fund some measures needed to address some political and policy health care issues with the current GOP health plan?

Site neutrality, at least the partial version, has passed the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Energy and Commerce and has been scored by CBO as saving \$40 billion.

Why not add this partial site neutrality to the health care package to provide funds to put additional provisions in the bill to secure the votes needed to pass it on the House floor?

To reiterate: given the current dynamics surrounding the House health plan, this is a great opportunity to secure some conservative healthcare policy – less government waste and less distortion in the market - and \$40 billion in savings, too, by adding partial site neutrality that has already passed through several committees to your health plan.
